

## Groovin' on Aug. 1 to feature big band

**G**roovin' in the Park, the Deltaville Maritime Museum's casual, outdoor, concert series, will continue this coming Saturday, Aug. 1, with a special performance presentation featuring the Good Shot Judy band with openers Honeywind Bluegrass Boys. The Bluegrass Boys begin at 5 p.m. and Good Shot Judy hits the waterfront park stage at 6 p.m. We have received confirmation from both groups. This concert is partially sponsored by Hawkins Boat Brokerage in Deltaville. Gates to the venue open at 4 p.m.

Following the phase three restrictions and to limit cash handling, the event will go to an all-ticket or online purchase entry and purchase system. Separate tickets for food and drink will also be sold at the event for the same reason. This show requires a special performance ticket.

From Good Shot Judy's website: "Good Shot Judy is Virginia's premier big band specializing in delivering top-notch classic vocals and recreating the classic nightclub entertainment feel of Las Vegas in its prime. Think Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Count Basie, glitz and glamour. (The band offers) real entertainment from an era that was not only filled with great singers, performers and great songs, but one whose legacy has become synonymous with great entertainment."

Possessing a large repertoire of classic swingin' big band hits, Good Shot Judy is also equally adept at delivering classic ballads and cocktail music. From the swingin' sounds of Sinatra, Basie, and contemporaries like Michael Buble and Harry Connick Jr., to the beautiful ballads of Ella Fitzgerald, Billie Holiday, and back to the high energy Latin Dance big band sound, Good Shot Judy has got you covered! Let's swing!

The hard driving bluegrass of the Honeywind Bluegrass Boys takes the stage at 5 p.m. Led by Mann Milby on guitar and vocals, they have been performing for 16 years out of Gloucester County with members from Gloucester, Newport News and York.

Due to coronavirus concerns, we will limit tickets to all shows this year. This may cause sellouts. Check the website. Tickets may only be purchased online or by calling the museum office. Unless there is a sell-out, you will be able to get tickets at the door from the cashiers at the Tea House on the museum's grounds. You may still purchase online using your smartphone and showing your receipt at the gate. You will be required to

have a ticket, or online receipt, and a mask to enter. We will not force anyone to wear a mask, but will require everyone to have one. Spacing lines will be marked on the concert grounds and we strongly suggest you bring your own lawn chairs.

Again, to limit handling, we will have cashiers from whom you may purchase tickets for our hot dogs, bottled water and mixed drinks. These will be our only food and drink offerings at this Groovin'. These tickets will be dropped into a bin when redeemed so the servers do not have to handle. We are working on adding these tickets to the website, so continue to check it out.

Groovin' in the Park will be rain or shine, outside only, in the waterfront park for the foreseeable future until restrictions for inside venues are relaxed.

Please watch the Southside Sentinel or our website for any changes. We will follow all Virginia COVID-19 regulation changes as they occur.

The third Groovin' is Aug. 22 with reggae band "Stuck on a Name."

The rest of the season is awaiting confirmation and is currently scheduled with:

- Saturday, Sept. 5 — Toby Gillie and the Unpredictables opening at 5 p.m. for the Josh Walker Quartet with Sharon Rae North.

Right now prices for regular performance tickets are \$10 advance, \$15/gate and special performances, \$15 advance, \$20/gate. All previously sold advance tickets will be honored.

Tickets are available on our website and by arrangement at the museum office. The Nauti Nell's store in Deltaville also has tickets. Children younger than 12 are admitted free.


