According to Newton, the county received a \$555,000 grant from the Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission to help with demolition.

Newton said she would not know the final cost of the demolition until after Oct. 31.

According to Newton, now that the old school building has been demolished, she has been working with the Virginia Economic Development Partnership (VEDP) to have the site listed.

"Having this site listed will allow for prospective businesses/industries to see the information for the site when going through the state site selection process," Newton said. "I also am working with the executive director for Virginia's Growth Alliance (VGA) to promote this site when he is aiding in the recruitment for prospective businesses/industries for Lunenburg County as well as the other localities in VGA."



The site where the former middle school once stood is now vacant following the demolition of the building.

AAA noted that high crude prices (above \$80

per barrel) remain the main culprit for rising pump prices in a recent press release.

at 45 mph, and it is a 25 mph speed limit," Pennington said.

At the July Board of Supervisors meeting, citizen Patricia Harper-Tunley presented a petition to the Board requesting a through truck restriction sign be erected.

"The trucks are moving at a high rate of speed through a fully populated residential area, noise levels increased, and the roads are showing stress areas from the constant travel of the oversized, fully-loaded trucks," Harper-Tunley said. "The possibility for an accident that would involve loss of life or limbs is an imminent threat to this neighborhood of predominantly African American residents."

As part of the Through Truck Restriction Program, localities can request that VDOT evaluate certain routes for the need to post signage that restricts through trucks (trucks with no stops along the roadway) from using the route.

"In this case, both the Town of Victoria and Lunenburg County would need to pass resolutions requesting the restriction, as the route needs to have logical start/end points and must have a viable alternate route from the initial point of restriction. This alternate route would likely travel into both localities." Bethanie Glover, Richmond District communications manager for

VDOT, said.

According to Glover, if the localities hold public meetings and come to a unanimous decision to request a through truck restriction, VDOT then has nine months to respond to the request with a final decision.
