

### ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

The Deadline to Register in Person is Tuesday, October 12th.

Monday, October 11th - Registrar's Office will be closed on Columbus Day

### HOW DO I KNOW IF YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

To register to vote or check your status online:

1. Access the following link:

Virginia Department of Elections citizen portal [www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal](http://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal)

2. Scroll to the bottom of the page, click Go.

3. Enter your name, date of birth, last 4 digits of their social security number and their locality.

And check the certification box.

4. You will now see your voter record

## WITNESS SIGNATURE REQUIRED ON ALL ABSENTEE BALLOTS

The Virginia Department of Elections wants to remind voters that witness signatures are required on all absentee ballots

If a general registrar finds after examining a returned absentee ballot envelope that the witness signature is missing, the voter will be notified within three days after receipt in the registrar's office that the ballot requires modification. The voter will have until noon on the third day after the election (November 5, 2021) to correct their ballot for it to be counted.

ELECT encourages voters to return their absentee ballot at their earliest convenience. A voter may return their absentee ballot by delivering it to:

- The USPS or a commercial delivery service (such as FedEx or UPS). All absentee ballots include pre-paid postage through the USPS.
- Drop box at Registrar's office
- The Office of the General Registrar
- Drop boxes at each Polling precinct on Election Day

Completed absentee ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received by local registrars by noon on Friday, November 5, 2021. If a ballot is personally delivered, it must be returned to the general registrar's office or drop-off location by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Voters who have requested an absentee ballot can track their ballot here: <https://v2.ballotscout.org/virginia/search/state>. If a voter is concerned that they do not have enough time to return their ballot by mail, ELECT encourages voters to personally deliver their ballot to their local general registrar's office, a ballot drop-off location, or vote in-person.

# Kavaliers move to 7-0

The Kenston Forest Kavaliers moved to 7-0 after defeating Chincoteague High School 58 to 6 on Friday, Oct. 8. Senior quarterback Tyler Turman threw 4 touchdown passes for 178 yards and rushed for a 5th touchdown on a 52-yard rushing touchdown late in the 2nd quarter. "Seniors Trey Lewis and Kendall Thorne finished with multiple touchdowns catches and led the Kavaliers to victory with their intensity and leadership," Coach Joseph Kaiser said.

The Kavaliers will return to action Friday, Oct. 15 away at Greenbrier Christian Academy.

# Autumn Fire: Burning the Valley, Part 2

On Saturday, Oct. 16, at 1 p.m. Sailor's Creek Battlefield Historical State Park will host a program about the military campaigns within the Shenandoah Valley during the last year of the Civil War in what was often referred to as the "breadbasket of the Confederacy" and "back door" to Washington. The presentation will be led by The Rev. Jeffery C. Schroeder, S.T.M., visiting lecturer of Civil War History, who will discuss in detail what happened before, during and after the 1864 burning of the valley. If

you missed Part 1 of the presentation, a brief synopsis at the beginning of the lecture will catch things up for you.

Schroeder's academic background includes the B.S., M.A.R., M.Div., and S.T.M. degrees, the last-mentioned from Yale University Divinity School. He pursued additional graduate work at the Universities of Toronto and Oxford. Much of Schroeder's avocational interests have been dedicated to the history of the American Civil War.

This family-friendly event is free to the public. Current COVID restrictions shall be strictly observed, and seating will be arranged to accommodate proper social distancing. The purpose of Sailor's Creek Battlefield Historical State Park is to preserve the cultural landscape as it was in 1865 and to provide the historic setting to tell the story of the last major battle of the Civil War in Virginia before the surrender of Robert E. Lee's Army at Appomattox Court House and its impact on the citizens of Southside Virginia.
